

- **Backwards compatible.** The KP-7500 works just like the KP-4000 – no special or different configuration.
- The KP-7500 has an aluminum faceplate around the membrane top eliminating the issue that KP-4000's sometimes have with heat causing it to peel.
- The KP-7500 has the ability to produce custom tones, instead of the standard 'beep' with the KP-4000.
- QSR ControlPoint software has more control over the KP-7500 so you can test every key directly from ControlPoint and troubleshoot issues.
- The KP-7500 has programmable scan codes so it can be used with other applications other than QSR ConnectSmart Kitchen software (CSK).
- The KP-7500 has a new, automotive grade polymer encasing that is more robust than the KP-4000's aluminum enclosure.
- With the KP-7500, you can use the standard PS/2 cable or you can use the more accessible USB cable.
- The KP-7500 is the exact same size of the KP-4000 – so no need to replace any keypad brackets.
- The KP-7500 offers all of these advantages over the KP-4000 at the same price.

- If you have ordered the KP-7500 with a PS2 cable, simply attach the extension cable to the attached PS2 'pigtail'.
 - If you have ordered the KP-7500 with a USB cable please note that the KP-7500 bump bar may come from the manufacturer with a short PS2 pigtail but it will also accommodate the USB cable that your requested. If you remove the base of the keypad (4 screws) it will reveal a mini-USB female connection. You can remove the pigtail and replace with the USB cable end that corresponds.
